1. Welcome and Introductions

Mr. Joshua Nelson, Chair of the Upper San Gabriel River (USGR) WASC, called the meeting to order. The District conducted a roll-call, and quorum was established.

2. Approval of Meeting Minutes from October 28, 2020

The District provided a copy of the meeting minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Nelson asked the committee member for comments or revisions. Mr. Bryan Urias made a motion to approve the meeting minutes with Ms. Kristen Ruffell seconding this motion.

The Committee voted to approve the meeting minutes from October 28, 2020 (17 Yes, unanimous).

3. Committee Member and District Updates

Ms. Melanie Morita (District) provided the District update noting: the launch of the Safe Clean Water (SCW) Portal and Dashboard, the Scoring Committee has begun scoring projects, all municipal transfer agreements have been sent out and the District has begun receiving annual plans, all regional transfer agreements are now out and the District has begun receiving scopes of work, and program reporting will likely begin in July.

6. Discussion Items:

a) Watershed Coordinator Selection

i) Process Overview

During the interview process, District staff will read each interview question and have it presented on the screen. Each Watershed Coordinator (WC) will be allowed 20 minutes to answer all the questions. District staff will manage a timer and provide a time remaining reminder to the interviewees at the end of the interview and then 10 minutes will be allowed for follow up questions and answers. Committee members were sent the set of WC interview questions, note-taking sheet, the WC roles/responsibilities, and each WC's Statement of Qualifications (SOQs). It is important to write notes to remember critical information when voting at the next meeting, or should the Committee member present at today's meeting not be present at the following meeting (in this case, the meeting notes should be passed onto the alternate member). If any of the Committee members have a financial interest in any of the WC interviewees, these Committee members must recuse and remove themselves from the WC selection process. For WC applicants that did not meet the scoring threshold, debriefing meetings have already been scheduled with LA County Public Works' Contracts Division.

Ms. Carver asked if there is conflict of interest if one of the interviewees is currently a consultant for their organization. Mr. Nelson clarified that this would not be a conflict of interest because she has no financial interest in the company.

Mr. Nelson asked how many WCs were assigned to the USGR watershed area. Ms. Morita confirmed that USGR has one WC in their approved Stormwater Investment Plan (SIP).

Mr. Urias asked who would be reading the interview questions. Ms. Morita clarified she would be reading the interview questions and Mr. Nelson clarified that the committee members would have 10 minutes after the interview portion to ask questions.
